



## **POP CANS**



#### Yes

✓ empty, uncrushed beverage cans

#### No

\* items other than beverage containers

## **C**ARDBOARD



## Yes\*

- ✓ corrugated cardboard
- ✓ boxboard i.e. cereal boxes
- ✓ file folders
- ✓ business cards
- ✓ clean pizza boxes
- \* please flatten

## No

- **★** Styrofoam or other packaging
- **★** waxed soap/detergent or produce boxes
- \* cardboard with Styrofoam or plastic attached

#### **Rules and Regulations:**

- All users must be residents or landowners of Oliver Paipoonge
- Residents must have a Landfill Access Card issued by the Municipal Office
- Prohibited items:
  - Liquid & hazardous wastes, e.g. waste oils, flammables, paints, sewage
  - Animal carcasses
  - Please see the Municipal website for a full listing of prohibited items
- Burning of waste prohibited
- No smoking
- No scavenging
- Obey posted speed limits
- Residents must deposit waste and recyclables in designated areas:
  - √ Household garbage
  - ✓ Recycling
  - ✓ Scrap metal & white metal
  - ✓ Local building materials, construction and demolition debris
  - ✓ Brush and old lumber for burn pile
  - ✓ Used tires
  - √ Waste electronics and electrical equipment
  - ✓ Fridges, freezers, air conditioners (see below for more information)

# Disposal of refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners:

Residents must have the Freon removed by a certified technician before any items will be accepted at the Landfill Sites. Please ensure there is a ticket attached showing the removal of Freon prior to disposal at the Landfill Site.
